Old Vine, Old Clone Zinfandel *Lodi/2006*

Wine enthusiasts covet the Old Vine, Old Clone Zinfandels from Lodi, where these vines were first planted in the 1850s. This appealing, medium bodied Zinfandel is accented with Petite Verdot and Syrah and is an excellent example of California's signature varietal, filled with flavors and aromas of fresh blackberries, currants and raspberries with mild oak accents. 6 84586 47001 5

Moscato *Lodi/2011*

Perhaps the world's oldest varietal, Moscato is known for its rich honeysuckle and citrus fragrance and ripe peach, mango and pineapple flavors. This release is an off dry combination of Muscat of Alexandria, Muscat Canelli, Viognier, Riesling and Chenin Blanc and is ideal before meals, with appetizers or with spicy Thai, Indian, Asian or Latin foods. 6 84586 47002 2

Classic Dry Rosé *El Dorado County/2011*

Small lots of hand harvested Grenache, Cinsault, Mourvedre, Zinfandel, Cabernet Sauvignon and Syrah from vineyard elevations up to 2,000 feet created this refreshing Dry Rose. The style is reminiscent of the complex, food friendly profiles of the Old World; it is amazingly versatile and can be enjoyed with delicate foods as well as spicy and highly seasoned selections. 6 84586 47004 6

Marsanne *Lodi/2011*

The great white wine grape of the Rhone Valley is blended with a touch of Viognier and Chardonnay, producing an austere and steely white wine with hints of fruit and spice. Seafood, white pasta and dishes with rich, creamy sauces pair well with the crisp acidity and dry finish. 6 84586 47005 3

Dark Wine *Lodi/NV*

A rich, elegant combination of Petite Sirah, Petit Verdot and Cabernet Franc. Very limited availability.

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
